The design must be adaptable onto any form / surface of publicity materials including souvenir items. Other than these two requirements, we are keeping the specifications open to let your creativity flow!

Format of Entries

Each entry must be accompanied by a completed competition form. You may submit as many as 3 designs. All entries should be submitted either by email or by post.
